Community is power.

I like to think I'm just one of those people who would rather not sit and ask what has the community done for me, but ask what have I done for my community, for my neighbour. I moved to Sligo in 2013, a new community, a new country, for a better life, most of my old life left behind, it was scary.

Coming through the asylum system is not easy, so many restrictions. But I thought - what is not restricted for me and found: music, so I joined the choir, which led to singing the national anthem in Irish. I sang for Prince Charles even and I kept giving to the community, and nothing got wasted.

It was a hard 2 years, but I started to suggest the same approach to others. I started a food project with a Sligo local Anne Spearman, we developed into serving for 500 people in a gorgeous gallery and cooking meals from our own countries for the community, bringing people together.

Community is power.
