

CASE STUDY: Women's leadership and community action: Virginia Carosielli, Italy

I am Virginia, I live in Celle di San Vito, the smallest town in Puglia (100 inhabitants) and I am the coordinator of the Franco-Provençal Language Desk.

I live in Celle because love brought me here, I have a 6year-old daughter and I am a home educator. I have found a community here that has welcomed me, appreciates me and helps me. Living in such a small town, where there are no services or "comforts", triggers a mechanism of reaction and adaptation, and you always have the famous "lever" with you that manages to turn weaknesses into strengths



My motto? The engine of a woman leader is humanity.

Celle is a village with a French-Provençal linguistic minority (there are three in Italy): we speak a language from the 1200s that fights against globalisation, the internet and standardisation. I have been studying and protecting for about 20 years now.

My work group is made up of all women and is very heterogeneous: all different, nothing in common except the love for the country. Different ages and different dreams.

We inaugurated a beautiful inclusive playground thanks to one of our projects, and on the day of the inauguration there were many children from neighbouring countries. They ask us to organise events or

I get very emotional and this perhaps conveys my sincerity to others. I am a woman, a mother and an educator, I can deal with crisis situations and difficulties with passion and a lot of patience.
